By entering the Hackathon you acknowledge that the Sponsor and/or the co-sponsors or promoters of the Hackathon may have developed or commissioned materials similar or identical to your Submission and you acknowledge and agree that neither the Sponsor nor the co-sponsors or promoters now have or will have in the future any obligation or liability (direct or indirect, vicarious, contributory or otherwise) with respect to the infringement or protection of your or any third party's patent, copyright or other proprietary rights in and to your content. Further, you understand that we will not restrict the work assignments of representatives who have had access to your Submission.

These items will be subject to vendor availability and may be exchanged for other options. Winners will be able to change the elements consisting the gaming set without exceeding the total amount of 200 euro. On the other hand, each participant of the winning team will deal with the shipping costs, in case of residing outside the Autonomous Community of the Canary Islands.

The prize, provided by Ecohuerta Canaria, consisting of a Deluxe fruit box and a deluxe vegetable box will be drawn on December 2nd, 2020 during the closure of the Agrisland Hackathon. All members of the participating teams may be part of the draw if they meet the following conditions. - Belong to a team that submits a solution to the Agrisland Hackathon.
- Residing in the Autonomous Community of the Canary Islands.
